- Hollow Spindle ($1\frac{3}{8}$ inch hole through.)
- Three Split Chucks, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch, $\frac{5}{8}$ inch and $\frac{7}{8}$ inch opening.
- Rest $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches long.
- Pulleys, tight and loose, 5 inches diameter, 2 inches wide.
- Length over all 18 inches.
- Weight about 150 pounds boxed.
